Bread Baking at the Lent Group - 04/03

"Man shall not live by bread alone." Matthew 4v4

I am perhaps being over-ambitious, but on Monday 4th March I am aiming to incorporate baking bread during the Lent group that evening (7:30pm start time). I would like to invite anyone to come and make some bread on the evening, even if you have not been to the previous sessions. There will be time with our hands on, mixing dough, but also time for it to rest and for us to have some time with reflection, refreshments and discussion about the feeding of the 5,000 from John's gospel. Of course people are welcome to come and watch others making and just join in for discussion and a brew.

My aim is to make baking bread seem perfectly do-able for anyone, with no prior experience and no special equipment needed. I believe homemade bread is delicious, good for you and better than anything you can buy at the supermarket. It is also fun and a great way to build our sense of fellowship when we bake together.

If you would be interested in taking part in the baking, it would be helpful to have an idea of numbers wanting to participate in making bread, so please let me know. Alternatively if you would be willing to lend me a hand

with some of the practicalities of running the session then do get in touch as well, as I'll need some extra help to pull this off!

Obviously we can't all bake in a single oven at church. So if you want to join in please make sure you have space in your fridge at home for whatever you will bake your bread in (unless you want a midnight feast!), and time the following morning to bake it at home (usually only around 40 minutes). If that's not possible for you but you would still like to join in, just have a word with me and we'll work it out (I like fitting bread baking around life).

For those wanting to bake please bring along the items below. I will have a few things spare but not enough for everyone. The rest will be supplied.

- Two mixing bowls (large if possible, or just one will be ok)
- Clean tea towel (or two)
- An apron
- A large 2lb loaf tin (or two small 1lb ones or baking tray, pot, dish, roasting tin, almost anything oven proof really)
- A large bag to take things home in

The Lent groups will continue each week, at St Mary's on Mondays and at Settle Parish Church on Wednesday evenings. There may be a Lent lunch event coming up. Watch this space for more on this later in Lent.

Calling All Volunteers! - 02/03

Recently we have been trying to include more people in the activities of the church, through things like the small groups leading worship from time to time. This has been very positive and a great encouragement to us all.

For those activities outside of church services, we are looking to get a little more organised. So Sharon Rucastle (our Parish Safeguarding Officer) and I are hosting a morning and invite all existing and prospective volunteers to help us get things in order. establishing good procedures and making sure everybody knows what is
expected of them. Anyone working with children, Pop Up Pantry
volunteers, PCC members and key holders should try to come. If you
cannot make it on the day, let me or Sharon know and we will make other
arrangements. Thank you.
